Buyer Responsibility

The buyer is responsible for thoroughly evaluating a horse before purchasing. This includes, but is not limited to, assessing:

- Conformation and soundness
- Size and suitability
- Temperament and attitude
- Training level and riding ability
- Manners on the ground and under saddle

We strongly encourage buyers to ask questions, request additional videos, speak with us directly, schedule a visit when possible, and arrange a prepurchase exam with a veterinarian of their choice.

Purchasing a horse without adequate research, communication, or evaluation is done at the buyer's discretion. Once a horse is purchased, ownership and responsibility transfer to the buyer.
